

Thank you for your recent letter requesting our support. I regret that demands on our limited funds and personnel resources are always such that we have to turn down many worthwhile requests.

Most of our support for educational activity is aimed at encouraging joint activities between education and industry, to develop mutual understanding and partnership. This is done through Link schemes close to the main BP sites, production of educational resources and support for key educational development programmes, eg introducing more young people to the excitement of engineering and increasing the numbers going on to a college education. Inevitably, the nature of much of this work means that resources are committed well in advance, which limits our capacity to respond positively to new proposals.
